All Homes In Two Tracts To Have Fallout Shelters

THOUSAND OAKS, Calif.—Completed in 18 months, the UPS Nuclear fallout shelter program will come with every home built in new housing contracts in the Southern California area.

"This is the first large-scale attempt to incorporate shelters in the homes," said Richard Dornbusch, president of the Pacific Nuclear Corporation.

The \$60 houses in the two tracts will range in price from \$17,000 to \$30,000 with the steel frame and concrete walls being part of the house and included in the purchase price. Construction is expected to be seven months.

A future fire inside that will keep out nuclear fallout shelter will be built in a steel shell. The shelter will be airtight and have a family of six said Dornbusch.

The house will be of six inches thick concrete walls and a roof of six-inch concrete block covered by 18 inches of earth.

The \$60 houses in the two tracts will range in price from \$17,000 to \$30,000 with the steel frame and concrete walls being part of the house and included in the purchase price. Construction is expected to be seven months.

Smog Indicted In Early Health Studies

For most people, getting into this poor air and, if you're young in enough, getting out of it and to smell it.

In Los Angeles, you can make your eyes smart and water. How dirty does pure air

have to get before it's unhealthy to breathe it? How much dirtiness is safe? What are the effects of noise? What are the effects of real air pollution. There are many things to consider.

Chemists and engineers can calculate a particular gas or particle that is considered healthy level—say in a factory or power plant—but is it healthy for humans? What are the effects of noise? What are the effects of real air pollution?

Tucson had air that was considered healthy for 90 per cent of the time during a 10-month study in 1959-60, but the city's smog was considered unhealthy levels in the general atmosphere where people live for 24 hours instead of 10 minutes.

Our air was rated relatively clean—the highest rating on the scale of 100, with 100 being the limit. The city's air is cleaner than the national average, which is about 68, and the in-between cities.

Tucson had air that was considered healthy for 90 per cent of the time during a 10-month study in 1959-60, but the city's smog was considered unhealthy levels in the general atmosphere where people live for 24 hours instead of 10 minutes.

A U.S. Public Health Service air sampling, at

Sacramento, Calif., showed the air in Phoenix, and the Phoenix air is far cleaner than the air in Los Angeles. It's all relative.

In Los Angeles, there were 60 days of eye-watering smog in 1959 and 72 days of smog in 1960. The smog in 1960 was more concentrated, moderately dirty and remained unhealthy and relatively clean, air, 92 per cent of the time.
